## SACRED HEART HIGH SCHOOL

Oliver Goll Trust Fund - Mr. Oliver Goll, a former resident of Carrick Township has established a trust fund to provide scholarships for graduates of Sacred Heart High School who proceed to a recognized post-secondary college or university programme.

John Korman Trust Fund - The late Mrs. Gertrude Korman established a trust fund to provide scholarships for graduates of Sacred Heart High School who proceed to a recognized university programme.

Snider, Reichard, March Scholarship - Don Snider, a partner in an architectural firm, has established a trust fund to provide scholarships for graduates of Sacred Heart High School who proceed to a recognized college or university programme.

Jessica Kirkland Memorial Trust Scholarship - Mr. & Mrs. Robert Kirkland established a trust fund in memory of their daughter, to provide annual awards to students graduating from "French Immersion Courses" and who proceed to a recognized college or university programme.

Dr. David J. Berberick Scholarship - The family of the late Dr. David Berberick established a trust fund to provide awards to graduates of Sacred Heart High School who proceed to a college or university programme in veterinary medicine, nursing or a related profession.

Tegler Bursary - The late Robert Tegler, formerly of Carrick Township, established a trust fund to provide bursaries for graduates of Sacred Heart, Mildmay and Sacred Heart High School, Walkerton who have completed at least one year, and are accepted into a subsequent year, at a recognized post-secondary college, university or apprenticeship programme.

Groch Memorial Scholarship - This award to a graduate of S.H.H.S. who proceeds to university.

Paul Serre Memorial Education Scholarship - To be awarded to a student pursuing post-secondary education in the field of business administration, commerce or finance. The student will, through passion and integrity, have pursued their maximum potential academically while selflessly being involved in one or more extra-curricular activities.

# APPLICATION PROCEDURES

#### Eligibility/Criteria:

To be eligible, a student must:

- 1) Be in full-time attendance at Sacred Heart High School for not less than one school year immediately prior to the student's graduation and the receipt of an award.
- Qualify according to the criteria established for the award.
  - a) Need determined in accordance with the fund or by the Awards Committee.
  - b) Scholastic achievement as directed by the fund.
- 3) Intend to and actually proceed to a recognized college or university.

### Application Process

- Obtain an application form from the Principal or Guidance Department at Sacred Heart High School.
- 2) Return the application to the Principal of Sacred Heart High School who will submit it to the Director of Education.
- Any individual who fails to submit an application by the due date cannot be considered for an award.

4) Recipients of an award will be announced at the appropriate ceremony of Sacred Heart High School.
