## ST. MARY'S HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS

### Scully Scholarships

A trust fund established by the late Albert A. Scully provides scholarships to students of St. Mary's High School who proceed to a recognized college or university. The awards are based on scholastic achievement.

### Scully Bursaries

A trust fund established by the late Albert A Scully provides bursaries to students of St. Mary's High School who proceed to a recognized college or university. These awards are based on financial need.

### Donald Joseph Bethune Memorial Fund

The family of the late Donald Joseph Bethune of Owen Sound established a trust fund to provide an award to a graduate of St. Mary's High School who achieved high scholastic standing and proficiency in music and proceed to a post-secondary institution.

### St. Mary's Parishioner Award

A parishioner of St. Mary's, who wishes to remain anonymous, has established a trust fund to provide an award to a special needs student who demonstrates scholastic achievement and proceeds to a post-secondary institution.

### Gerard Kroepelin Spirit of Sport Award

### Stella Keenan-McPeak Literary Award

To be eligible, a student must be a graduate from St. Mary's High School who demonstrates a love of literature and exemplary creative writing skills.

### Bruce-Grey System Bursary

This award to children of employees graduating from a high school operated by the Board, who proceed to university or college, or participate in an apprenticeship program.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURES

### Eligibility/Criteria

To be eligible, a student must :

- 1) Be in full-time attendance at St. Mary's High School, Owen Sound for not less than one school year immediately prior to the student's graduation and the receipt of an award.
- 2) Qualify according to the criteria established for the award.
  - a) Need determined in accordance with the fund or by the awards committee.
  - b) Scholastic achievement as directed by the fund.
- 3) Intend to and actually proceed to a recognized college or university.

### Application Process

- 1) Obtain an application form from the Principal or Guidance Department at St. Mary's High School.
- 2) Return the application to the Principal of St. Mary's High School who will submit it to the Director of Education.
- 3) Any individual who fails to submit an application by the due date cannot be considered for an award.
- 4) Recipients of an award will be announced at the appropriate ceremony of St. Mary's High School.
