# Energy Retrofit Plan

### Background

As part of the government's commitment to energy conservation, one-time funding of \$25 million will be provided to school boards in 2004-05 to assist them to undertake energy retrofit projects in their schools.

The objective of the Energy Retrofit Allocation is to improve energy conservation in schools and reduce energy costs over the long term. There is no intention to provide specific energy retrofit allocations in subsequent years.

### Examples of projects that produce energy savings and efficiencies:

- .energy efficient windows
- .energy efficient light fixture, lamps and ballasts
- .control systems to monitor and adjust energy use in schools
- .energy efficient water heaters and boilers
- .insulation in schools
- .sealing and weatherstripping to reduce air leakage
