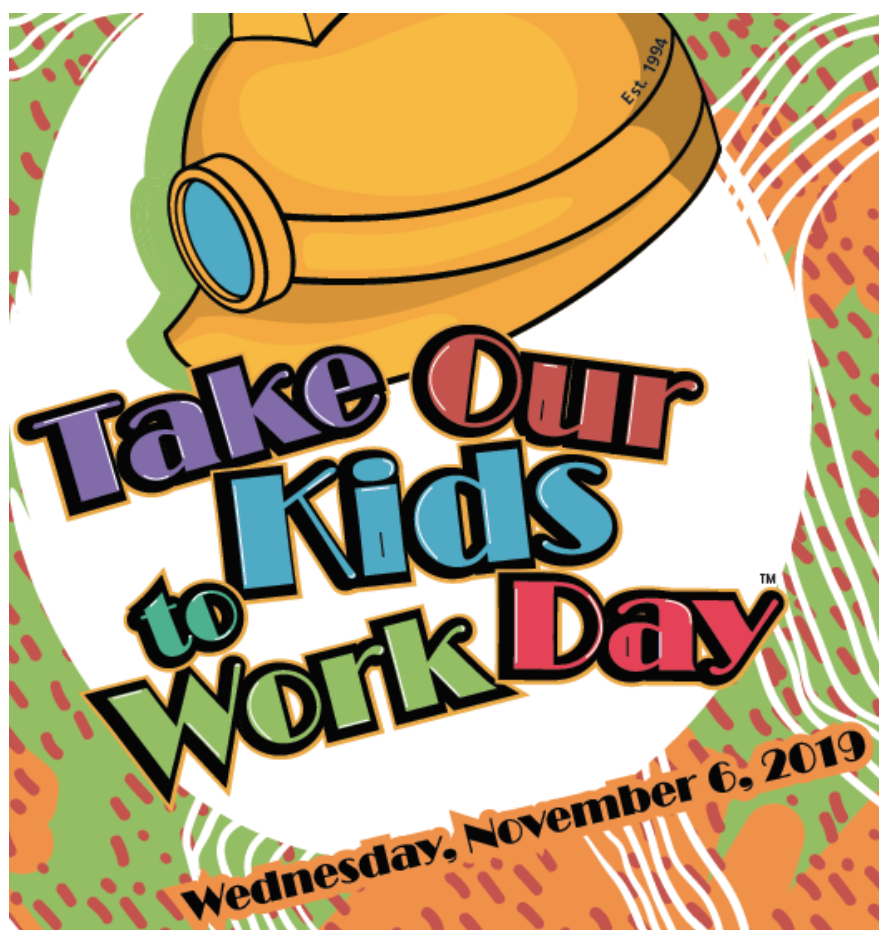

WORK SMART, WORK SAFE: Always think safety first. Don't fool around on the job.

REPORT UNSAFE CONDITIONS:

If you see something that looks wrong, tell your workplace supervisor.

DRESS FOR THE JOB:

Make sure your dress reflects the workplace environment. If your job requires you to wear protective equipment or clothing, wear it, making sure it fits you properly.

GET TO KNOW EMERGENCY PROCEDURES:

Ask your employer about emergency procedures in your workplace. For example, where are the fire alarms, fire extinguishers and fire exits located?

REPORT ALL INJURIES:

If you are injured in the workplace, seek first aid immediately. Then, be sure to report your injury to your workplace supervisor.
